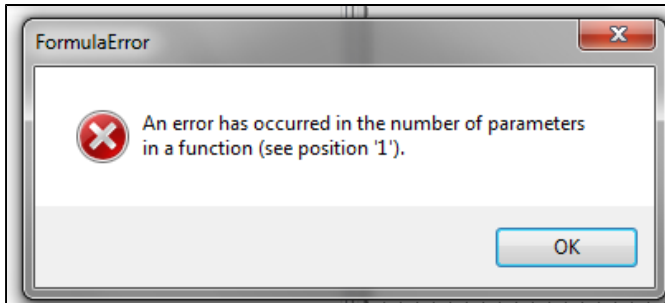




Question:

Answer:

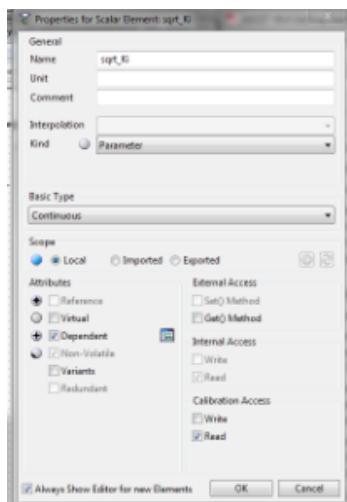
Add or remove parameters in the function

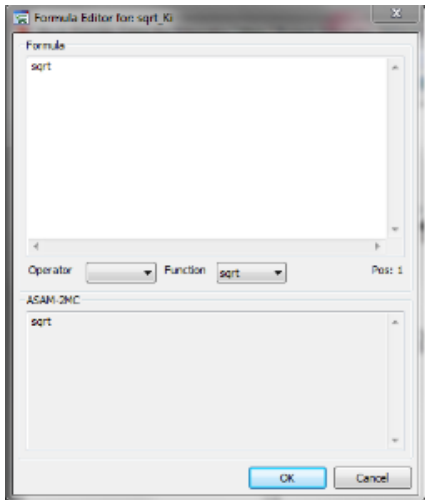
1 Steps to reproduce

1. In ASCET: Tree Pane -> Select a Continuous Parameter
2. Right mouse button -> Properties...



3. Under **Attributes**: Activate **Dependent**
4. Click on **Open Formular Editor** icon

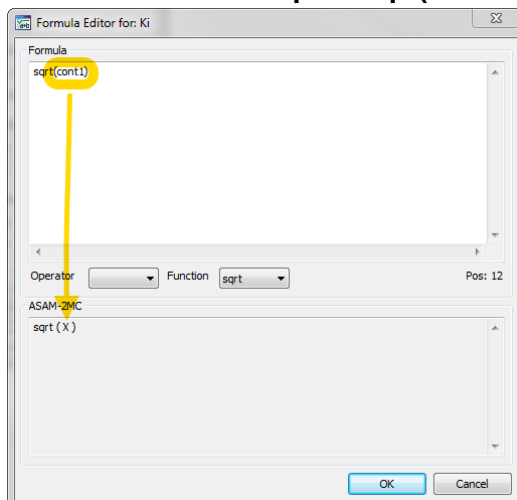
5. In Formula Editor: In Combo Box **Function**: Select any function, for example **sqrt**



6. Click OK button

2 Resolution

- Edit formular: From **sqrt** to **sqrt(<variable_name>)**, for example **sqrt(cont1)**
