



Question:

- Cannot open ASCET database (DB) via command **OpenDataBase (<AscetDatabasePath>)** method
- Protected folders in an ASCET Database
- How to open a password protected database via ASCET API?



Answer:

- Normally an ASCET DB can be opened using the following API commands:

```
Ascet tool = new Ascet();
```

```
myDataBase = tool.OpenDataBase(<AscetDatabasePath>);
```

- If this fails use the following commands to get more information:

```
int errCode = tool.GetToolErrorCode();
```

```
string errString = tool.GetToolErrorMessage();
```

- If the delivered error code (errCode) is **922** or the error string (errString) is **Password protected data storage** then
 - The database contains password protected items
 - Thus the OpenDataBase() command cannot be used
- Use the following code instead:

```
public AscetDataBase OpenProtectedDataBase(String dataBase, Int64 key);
```

```
public AscetDataBase GetCurrentProtectedDataBase(Int64 key);
```
