



- How to import or export preferences?
- Is it possible to share user defined options with team members?



Answer:

1 To export a preference file:

- 1. Select File > Export...
- 2. In the Export wizard: select **General > Preferences** and click **Next**
- 3. Click **Export all** to accept all of the preferences defined in the file
- 4. If you want to export only few preferences, choose them from the list
- 5. Click Browse... and locate the preference file on the file system
- 6. Click Finish

2 To import a preference file:

- 1. Select File > Import...
- 2. In the Import wizard: select **General > Preferences** and click **Next**
- 3. Click **Browse...** and locate the preference file on the file system
- 4. Click Import all to accept all of the preferences defined in the file
- 5. If you want to import only few preferences, choose them from the list
- 6. Click Finish



Additional information:

- The configured preferences options can be exported and imported
- The Preference export is done at the workspace level, allowing easily sharing individual or group preferences
- For example: ECU Extract preferences, Auto connection preference options & rules
- The export wizard can be used to export preferences from the Workbench to the file system
- This is one of the features provided by Eclipse itself

 - ASCET V7
 - ISOLAR-A
 - ISOLAR-EVE
