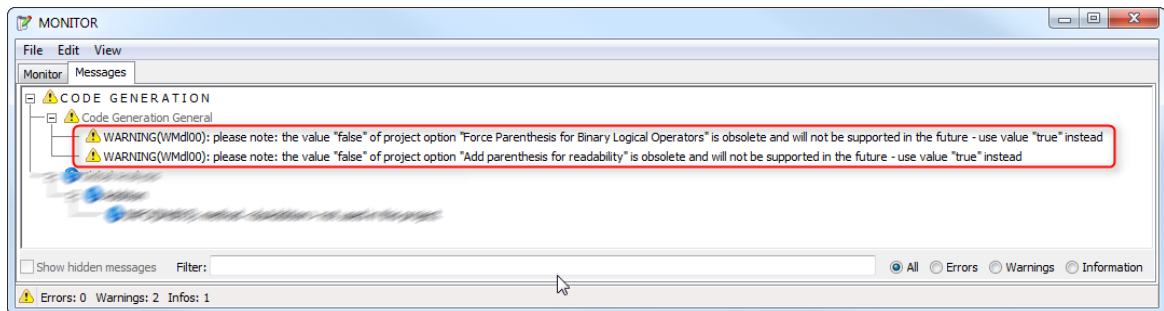




Question:

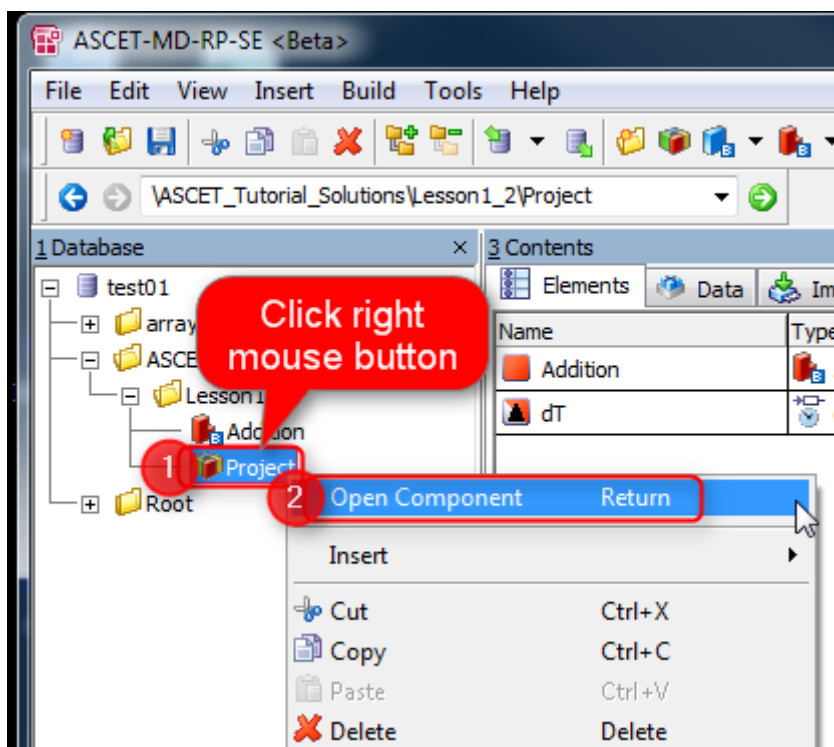


- How to get rid of this warning message?

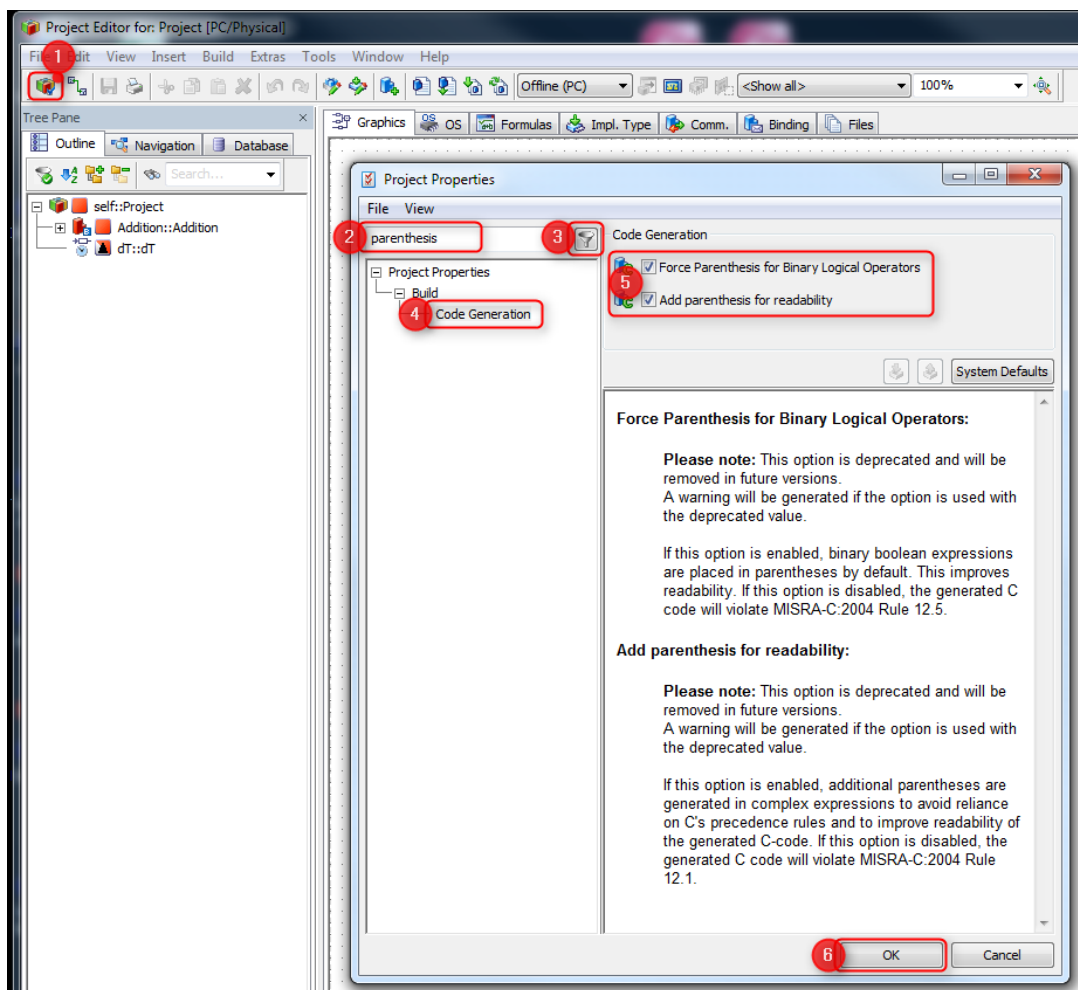


Answer:

- Open **Project Editor**:



- In **Project Editor > Project Properties > In search text field: type "parenthesis" > click "Filter" button > Code Generation**



- Make sure that **both** options are checked
- Click **OK** button
