

How to move my ASCET installation from drive C to drive D



- I am running out of disk space on drive C and want to clean it up
- I want to move my ASCET installation from drive C to drive D
- Is there a more convenient way than de-install on C and install to D?



• There is no more convenient way than de-installation and then installation to drive D



Additional information:

- It is not recommended to move applications from drive C for performance reasons
- We recommend to move data from drive C to drive D
 - Drive C: only applications
 - Drive D: only data
 - Applications need less disk space compared to data files like images, music and videos
- Use a tool (for example "Treesize Free") that shows what occupies the most space on the drive
 - For example: If there are some video files on the drive it most probably makes more sense to move them to another drive
 - Tackle the biggest files first
 - Do you really need them?
 - Can you delete them?
 - How often do you use them?
- In addition, make sure that drive C is not a mechanical drive but a solid state drive (SSD)
 - SSDs are significantly faster than mechanical drives
- If you are working with virtual machines then put them on drive C
