






I get a blue screen during installation of ASCET



## DPC\_WATCHDOG\_VIOLATION

- o PC is freezing when I want to install ASCET on Windows 10
- o Issue occurs on all new computers



#### Answer

- This behavior only occurs when INCA V7.2 was installed before ASCET
- Correct order of installation is to install ASCET before INCA V7.2
- o We are currently working on improving this behavior
- o Installing ASCET before INCA V7.2 will circumvent the blue screen during installation


#### Workaround:

- There is a workaround available
- o Workaround: Stop the ETAS services before starting the installation of ASCET
- o There are 2 ways to stop the ETAS services:
- Either stop the ETAS services manually or via command line



## Workaround 1: Stop ETAS services manually in the Windows Task Manager

 Start Windows Task Manager → tab Services: On ETAS service → Right mouse button click → Stop Service



Repeat these steps for all 4 ETAS services

#### Workaround 2: Stop ETAS services per command line

- Open a command line interface and execute the following commands
- You can put these commands into a ".bat" file if you want to:

```
net.exe stop "Etas Configuration Service"
net.exe stop "ETAS Configuration Service 2.0"
net.exe stop "ETAS System Time Service"
net.exe stop "ETAS System Time Service 2.0"
```
