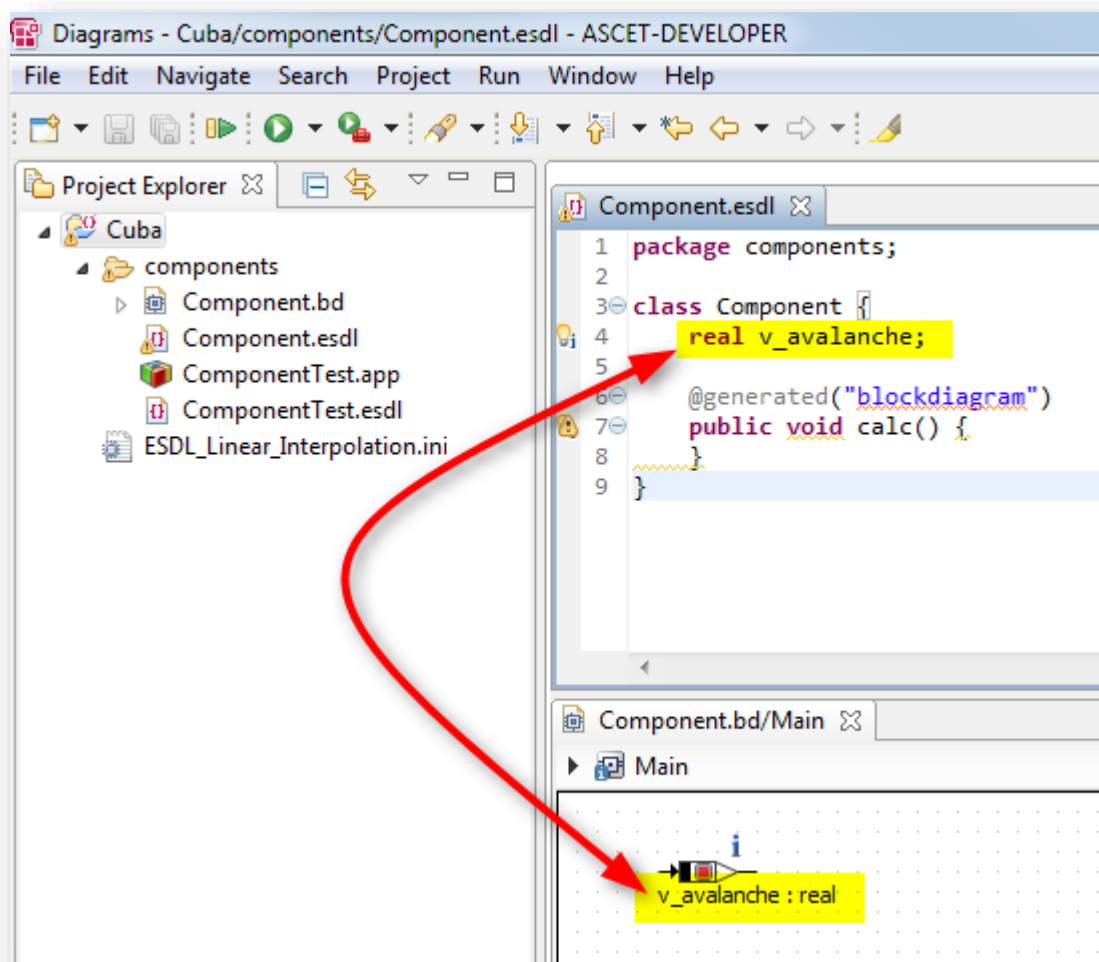


ASCET-DEVELOPER: Renaming a message (or any other component)



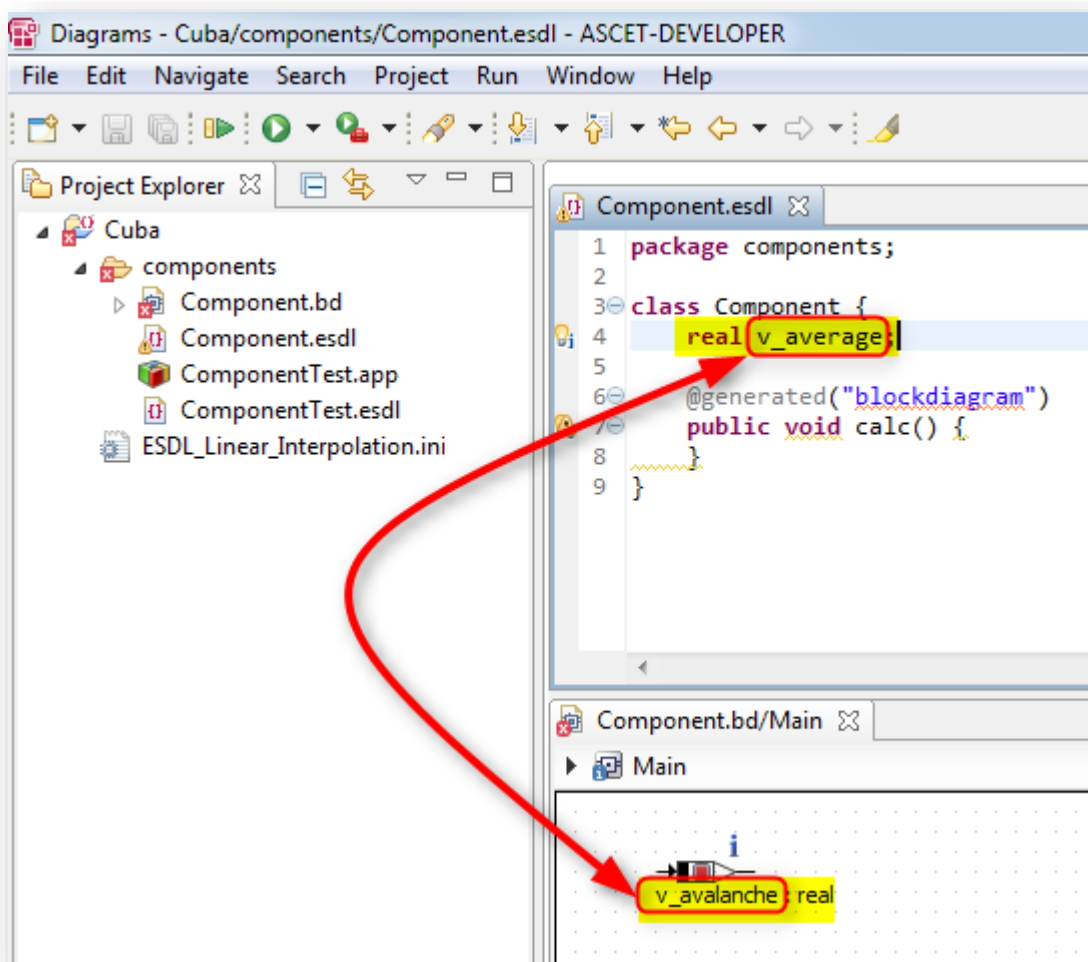
Question

- I want to rename an element in my ASCET model
- The current name is **v_avalanche**



- I want to change the name from **v_avalanche** to **v_average**
- I edited the name of an element directly in the ESDL file via text editor

- Now, in block diagram editor the name is still the old one



- Display of block diagram is not updated when a name is changed in the corresponding ESDL file

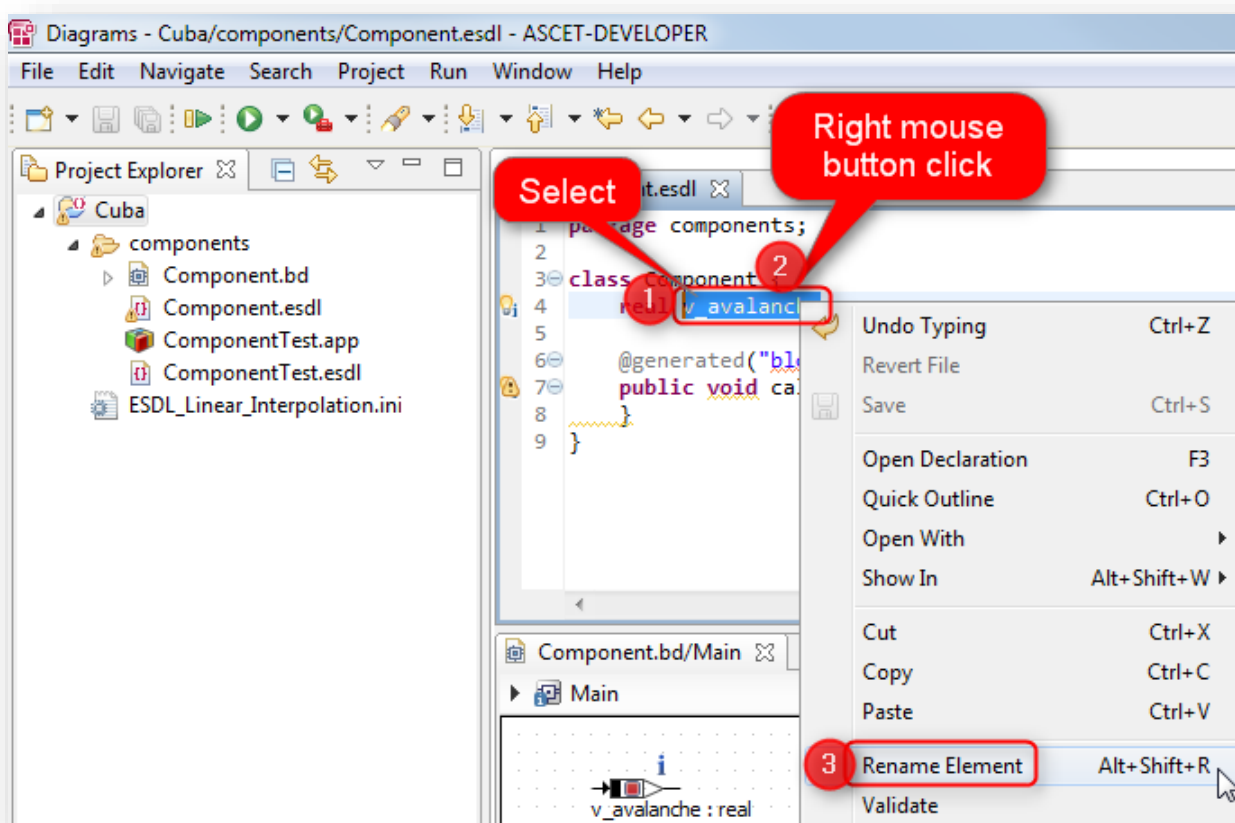


Answer

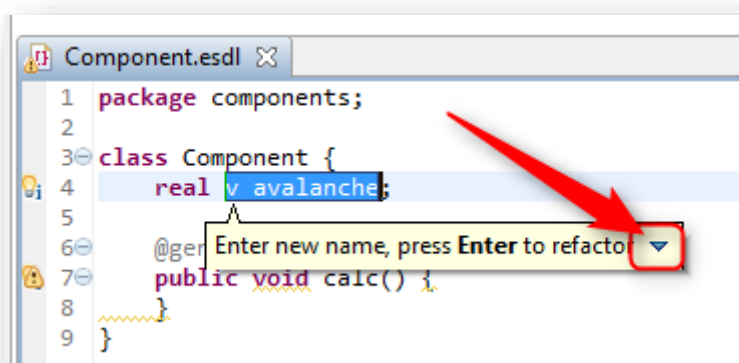
- In order to change the name of an element AND change all references to it one has to use the **Rename Refactoring** function
- Just editing the name directly in the ESDL file will not update the related references

Recommended way to rename any component:

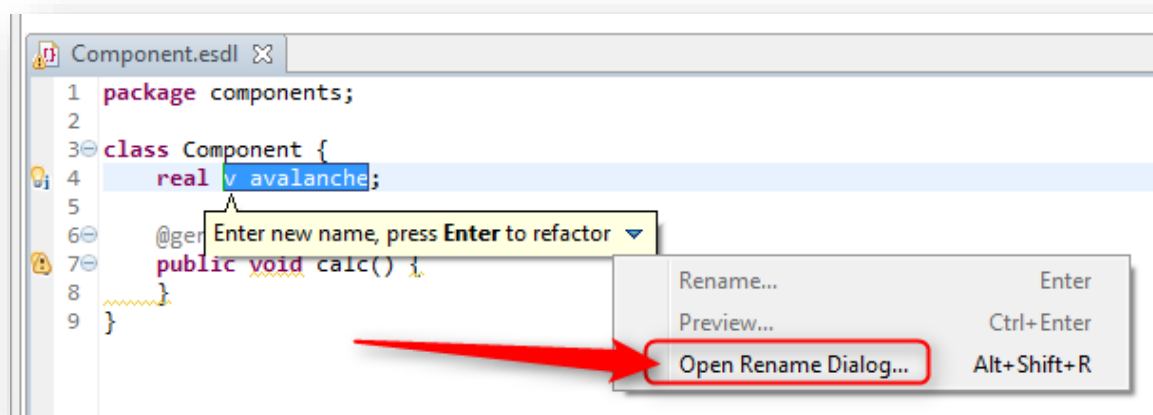
1. In ESDL file in text editor → Select the element you want to rename → Right mouse button click → **Rename Element**



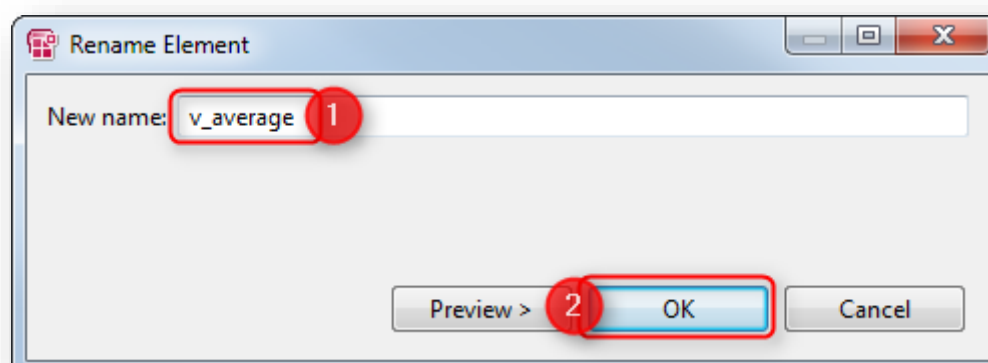
- Click on **blue triangle** on the right side of "Enter new name, press Enter to refactor"



- Click **Open Rename Dialog...**

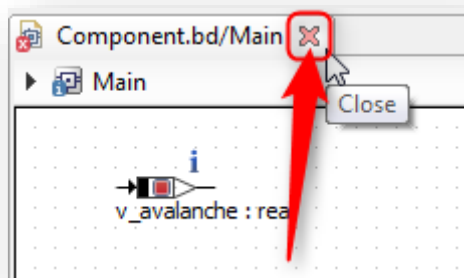


- In dialog **Rename Element**: Type new name → Click **OK** button

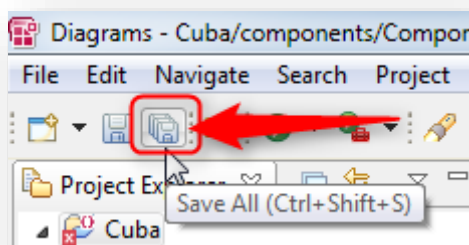


- Wait until Builders and Validators are finished (see in status line at bottom right corner)

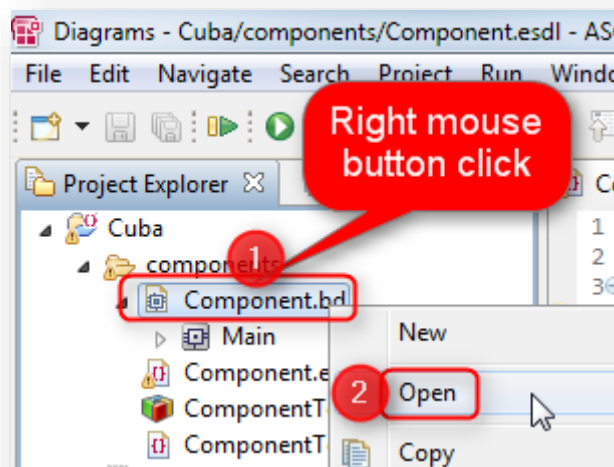
5. On block diagram tab → Click red X ("**Close**") icon



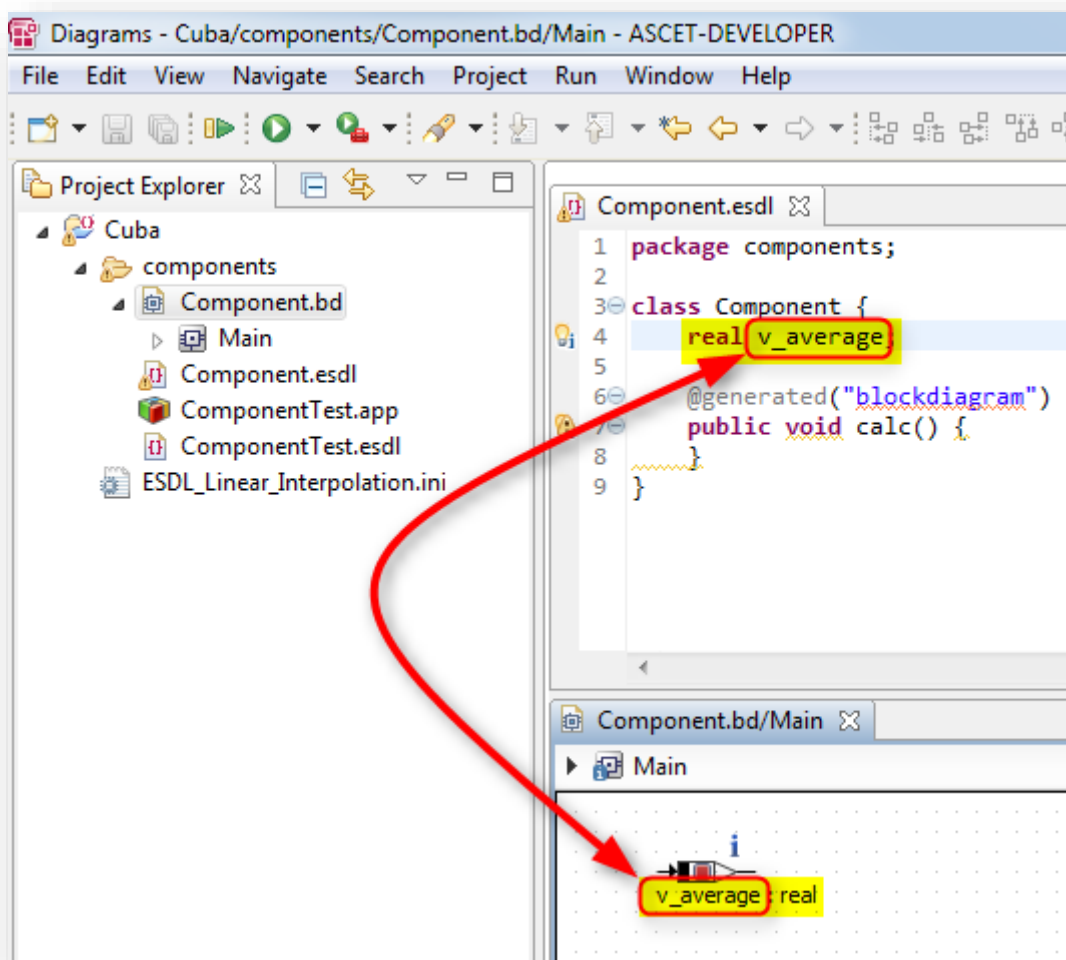
6. In ASCET-DEVELOPER → Tool bar → Click **Save All** icon



7. In **Project Explorer** on block diagram file: Right mouse button click → **Open**



8. Result: The element and reference is renamed
