

### ASCET: Header files are missing




- o Where are header files?
- Header files are missing
- There is only 1 header file generated while we expected several header files (one for each single C code file)
- o Where are variables and structs declarations?




## Check which folder is selected as output location for generated code files

- Per default, generated code files are written into folder C:\ETAS\ASCET<version>\CGen
- For example: C:\ETAS\ASCET6.4\CGen
- o ASCET offers the functionality to change this setting:
- 1. In **ASCET**  $\rightarrow$  Menu bar  $\rightarrow$  **Tools**  $\rightarrow$  **Options...**






2. In dialog Options → Options → Build → Paths → Panel Paths → Field Code Generation Path → Click folder button





 $\circ$  In dialog **Path Selection**  $\to$  Select directory for generated files  $\to$  Click **OK** button





### Per default, one C header file is generated for each component

- ASCET offers the functionality to configure this behaviour
- o The following options are available:
  - Component (default)
  - Module
  - Project

### o Component:


- o Generate one C header file for each component
- o File names are derived from the component name

#### o Module:

- Generate one C header file for each module
- o File names are derived from the module name


#### o Project:

- o Generate a single C header file for the complete project
- The file name is derived from the project name
- This option should be selected for best results in combination with option Supports precompiled header






- Check which option is selected in the project properties
  - In ASCET → Dialog Project Editor for: <Project> → Tool bar → Click Project Properties icon



2. In dialog Project Properties → Project Properties → Build → Field Header Structure: Click black triangle → Select Component
