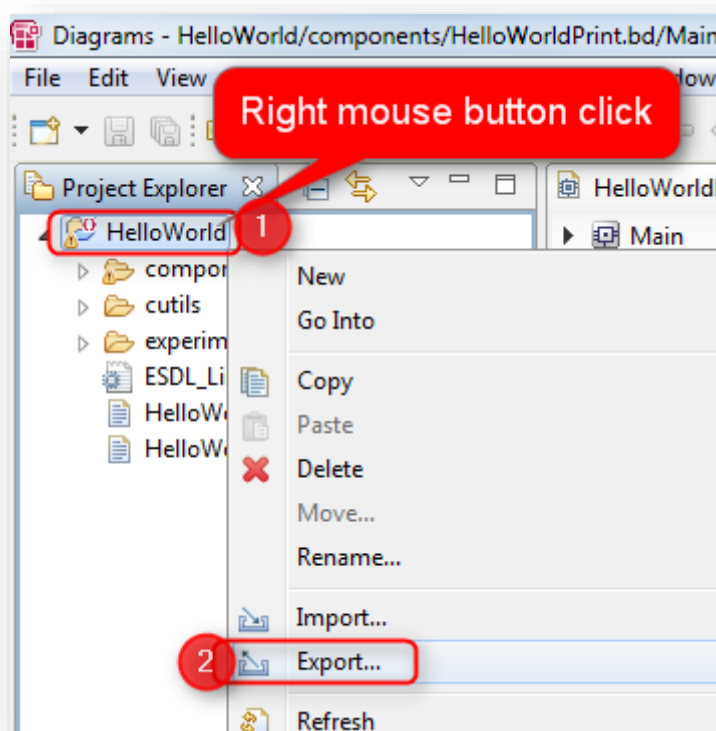

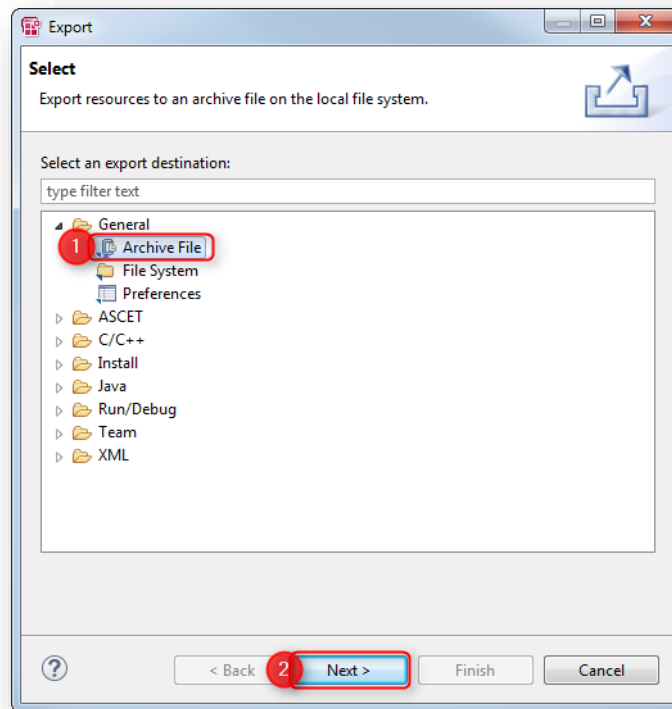
Step by step guide through the procedure

Export project to zip file

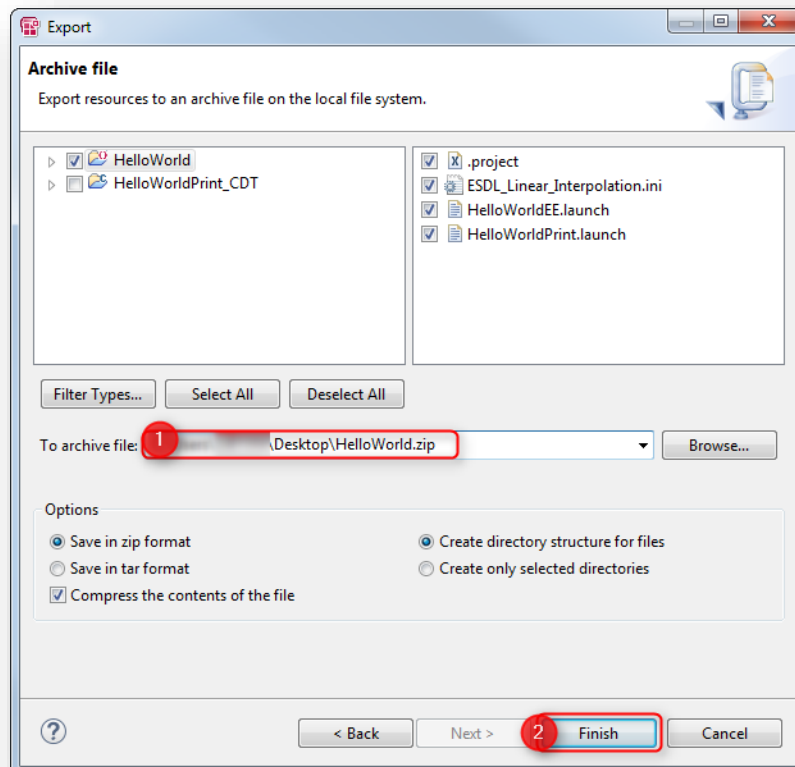
1. In **ASCET-DEVELOPER** → **Project Explorer** → On project: Right mouse button click → **Export...**



2. In dialog **Export (Select)** → **General** → **Archive File** → Click **Next >** button

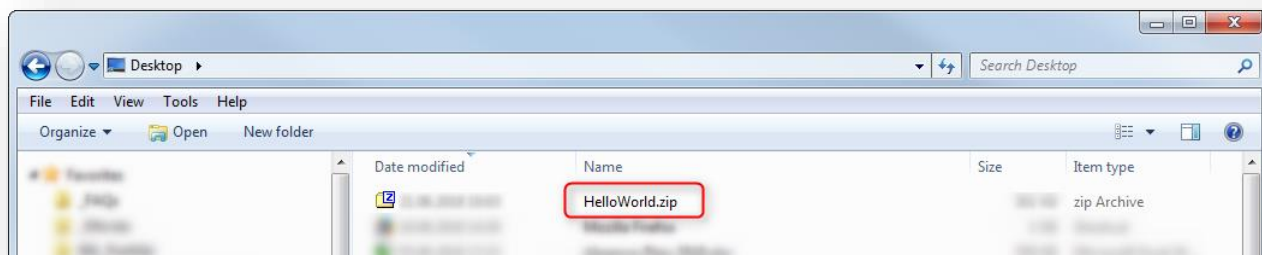


3. In dialog **Export (Archive file)** → Field **To archive file:** Choose path and file name of the archive to be generated → Click **Finish** button



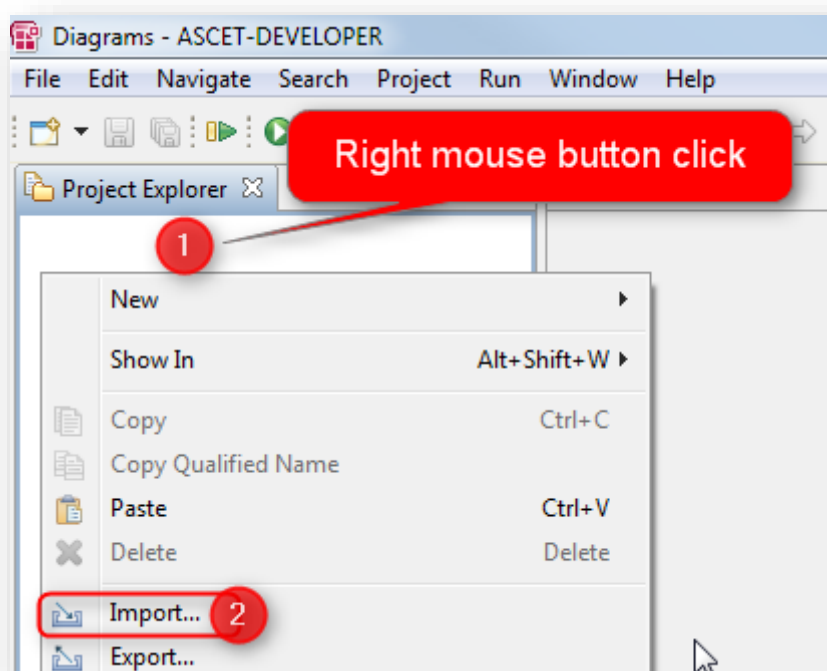
Transfer zip file

- o Transfer the zip file to destination per **mail** or **ftp** or any other **data exchange** method

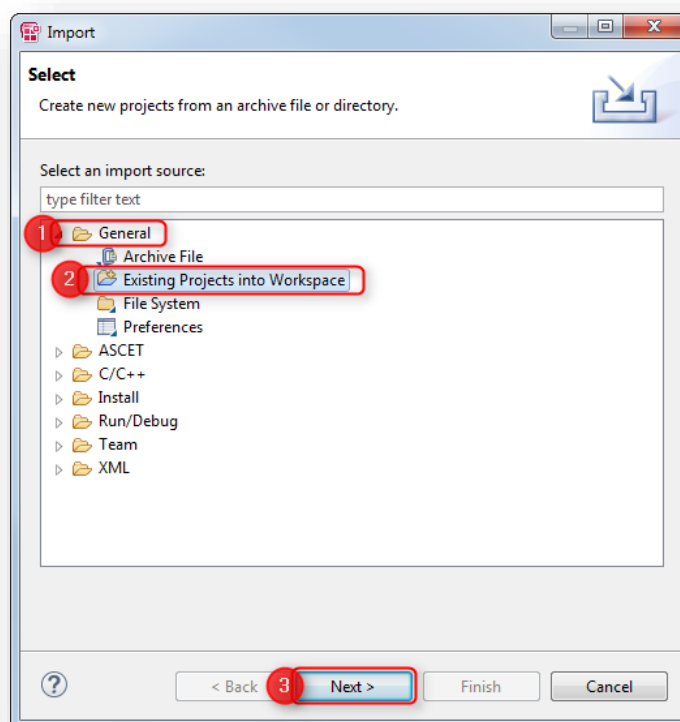


Import project

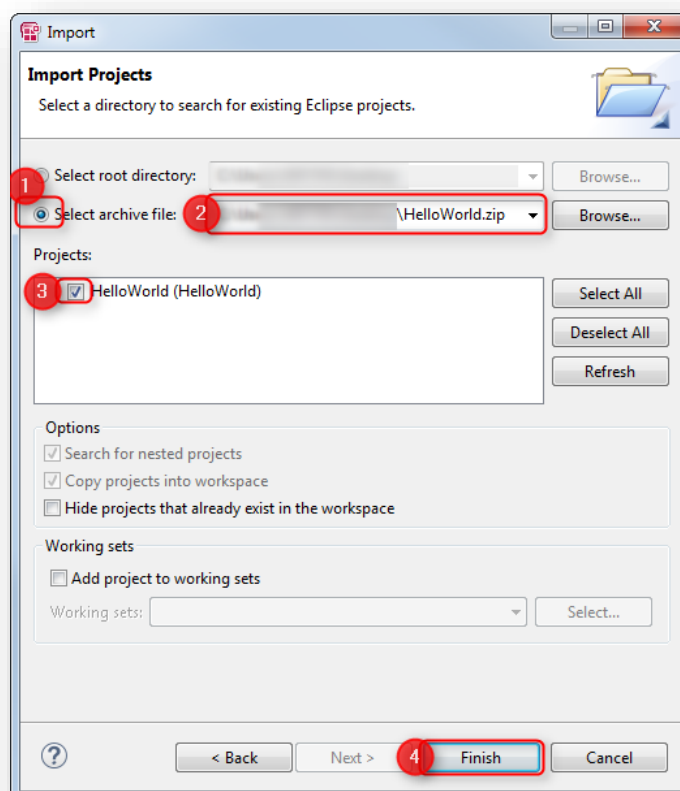
1. In **ASCET-DEVELOPER** → **Project Explorer** → Somewhere in white area: Right mouse button click → **Import...**



- In dialog **Import (Select)** → **General** → **Existing Projects into Workspace** → Click **Next >** button

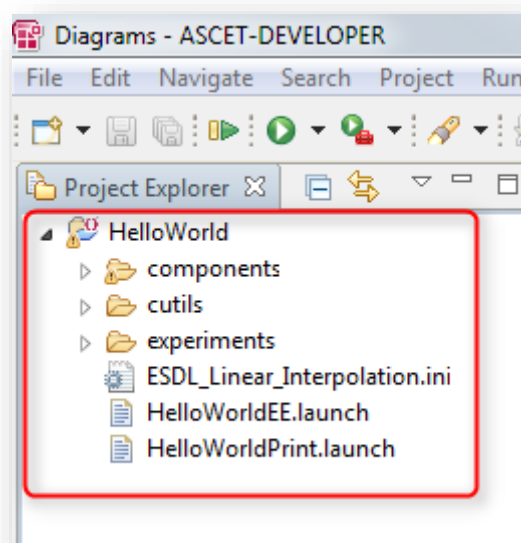


- In dialog **Import (Import Projects)** → Select archive file and project → Click **Finish** button
