



## Question:

**Why is it not possible to open two different .ehb containers with .a2l and .hex for comparison in EHANDBOOK-NAVIGATOR?**



## Answer:

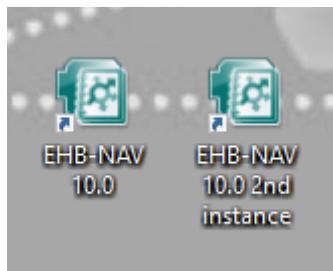
**Loading of multiple datasets into EHB-NAV is currently not possible. To achieve this, a second EHANDBOOK-NAVIGATOR instance can be started.**

With two (or more) instances of EHB-NAV started, different individual .ehb containers and a suitable datasets can be loaded and visually compared by arranging them side by side.

To start multiple instances of EHB-NAV, a separate workspace must be created for each additional instance. To do this, a separate desktop shortcut must be created and configured for a new EHB-NAV instance.

This works as follows:

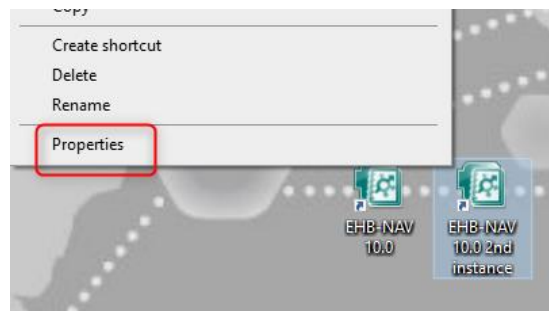
1. Copy the shortcut from EHB-NAV and rename it



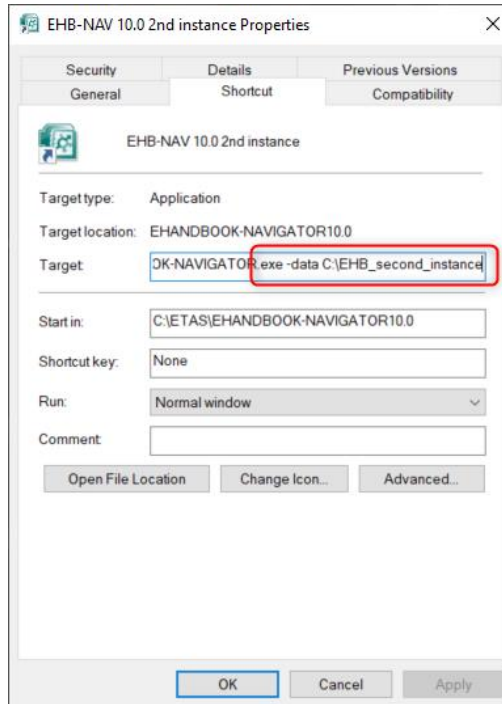
2. Create a new folder on the local drive where the temporary data can be stored

> This PC > (C:) Windows > EHB\_second\_instance

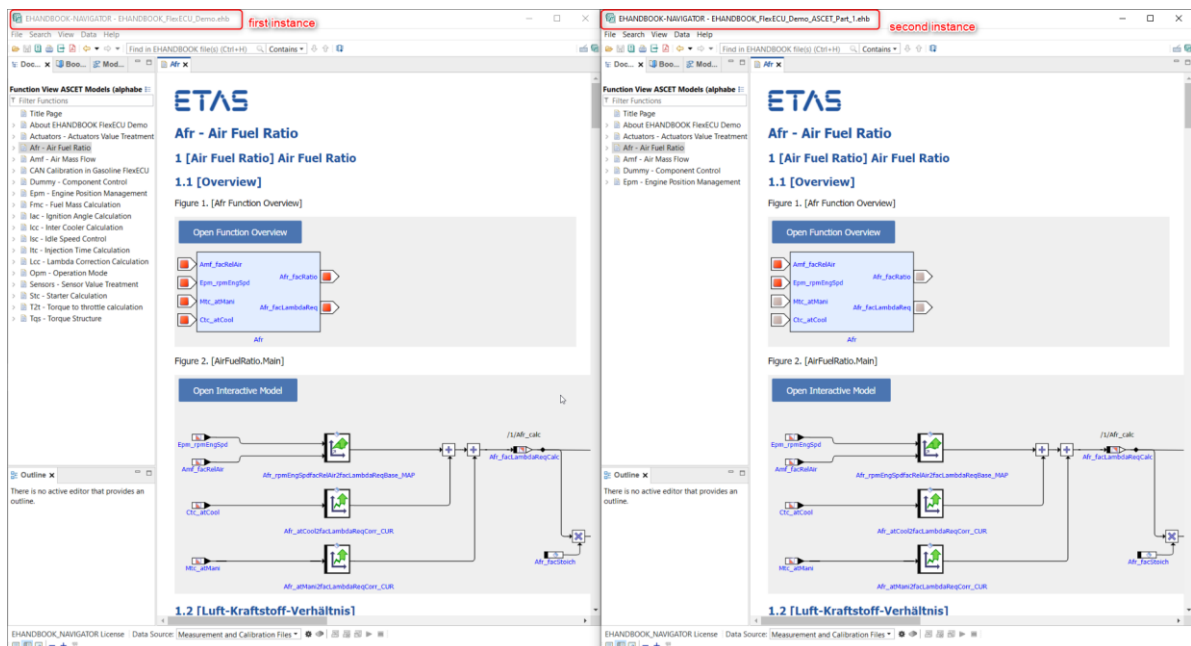
3. Over the context menu (right click on icon) and open the properties dialog for the shortcut



- In the field „Target“ add after EHANDBOOK-NAVIGATOR.exe the entry „-data <path to the directory>“



- The following scenario can be set up: 2x EHB-NAV, each with a different EHANDBOOK Container with software & dataset.
