



## Question:

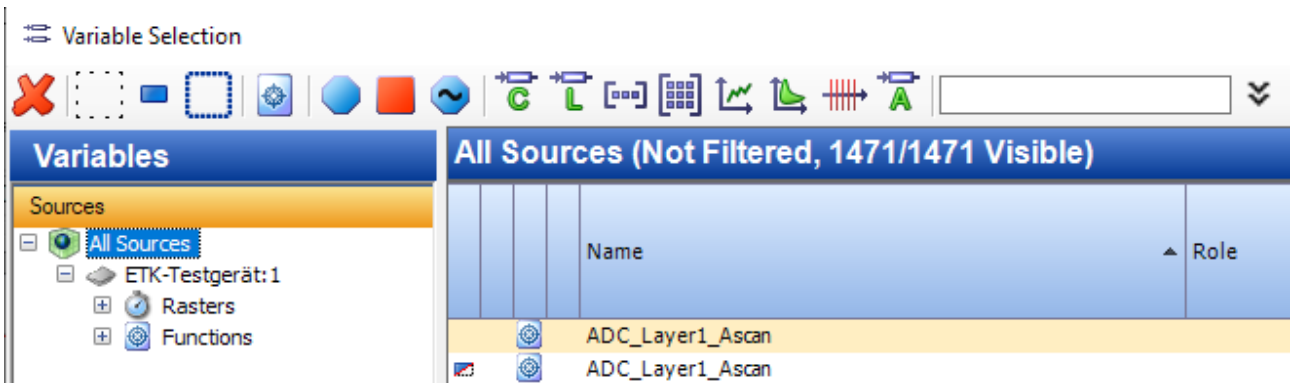
In the Variable Selection Dialog there is a feature which allows easy filtering of variables or functions; how can this source search box be activated?



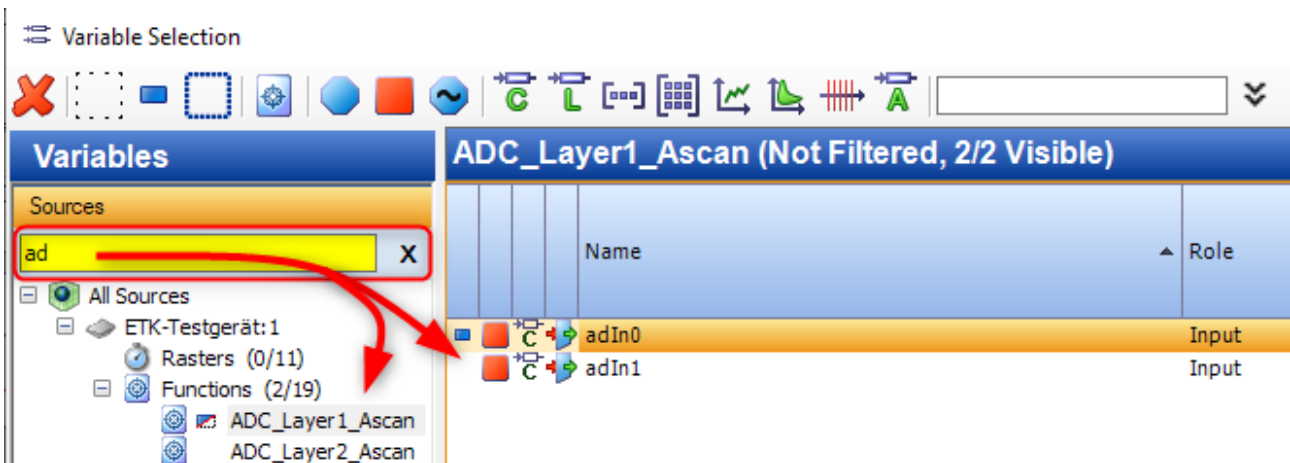
## Answer:

The search box can only be displayed in combination with the *Ctrl+f* key shortcut.

Open the variable selection dialog in the INCA experiment environment, the quickest way is to use the key combination *Shift+F4*.



Then use the key combination *Ctrl+f*. The search box can now be used to filter variables or functions as usual.



## Additional information:

If the search box is not displayed, *Ctrl+f* is the only way to reactivate it.
