




How can I search for all instances of a used signal in MDA V8?

Answer:


Consider the following scenario:

I would like to find out in which layer and in which window an already selected variable is located. For simplicity say I wish to find out where all the instances of *TMOT* are distributed over the 3 layers.




Proceed as follows:

In order to find out which variables are already selected, please toggle over the symbol to **Only displays used variables**.



In our example, we wish to find all instances of the variable TMOT.






Create a new empty layer and copy the variable *TMOT* into this layer.

In the oscilloscope in the newly created layer, click on the variable *TMOT* and copy this into the clipboard with the key combination Ctrl + c.

In the **Configuration Manager** tab, paste the variable *TMOT* from the clipboard with the key combination Ctrl + v into the search field. Now you see all instances of the variable *TMOT*.
