



## Question:

**How to describe a measure file with a short comment?**



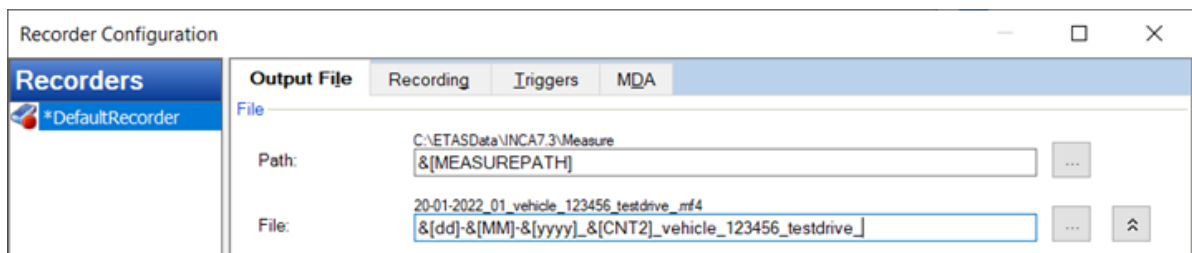
## Answer:

Since INCA V7.3.6 it is possible to describe your measure file after recording with the new "short comment" feature.

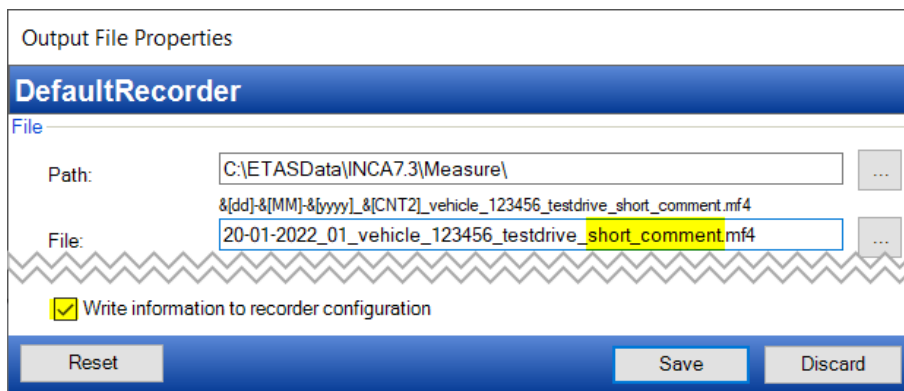
- Open the **Recorder Configuration** from the experiment:



- Create a measure file name e.g.:



- Start and stop the measurement to open the **Output File Properties** dialog and type in a short comment:



- While saving your measure file next time you can delete the old comment with backspace and type in an new one, because the cursor position is saved:
