



Question:

- Where does INTECRIO store tools' options?
- What is the directory where INTECRIO saves user preference settings?
- Where does INTECRIO store the settings of **Tools > Options**?



Answer:

- INTECRIO stores the user preference settings under following directory:
 - **C:/Program Files (x86)/ETAS/INTECRIO<x.y>**
 - Replace **<x.y>** with the according version, for example:
 - **C:/Program Files (x86)/ETAS/INTECRIO4.6**
- When INTECRIO is executed by an user **without admin privileges**:
 - The user does not have permission to write into the **C:/Program Files (x86)** folder
 - Therefore, Windows saves the file into an hidden folder where the user has writing permission:
 - **C:/Users/<USERNAME>/AppData/Roaming/ETAS/INTECRIO<x.y>**
 - Replace **<USERNAME>** by the name of the user
 - Replace **<x.y>** with the according version
 - The folder **AppData** is not visible per default.
 - It is a system folder of the operating system Microsoft Windows
- **WARNING:**
 - **Do not edit** the files in the given folder and subfolders!
 - The content of the files is not meant to be human readable in first place
 - There is no documentation about this files available
