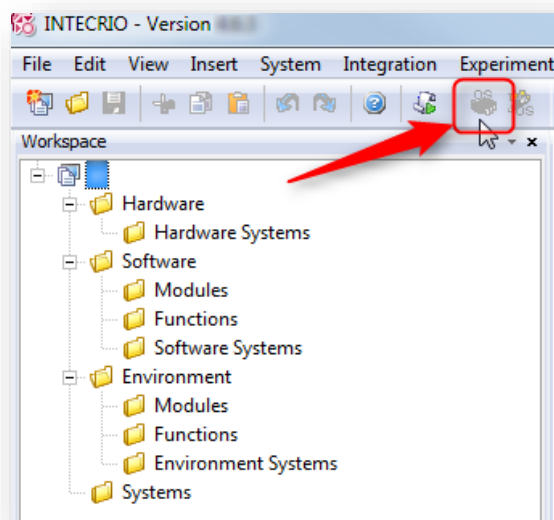

- Cannot open OS Configuration dialog



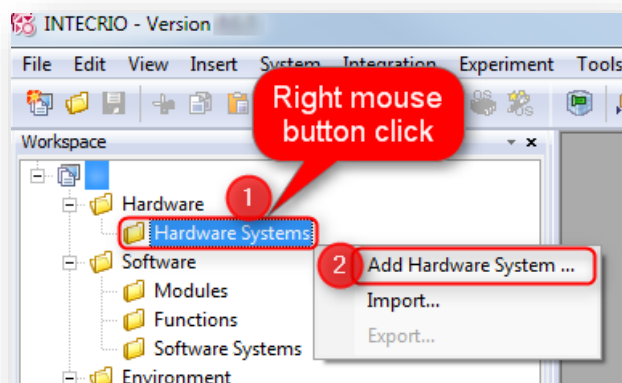

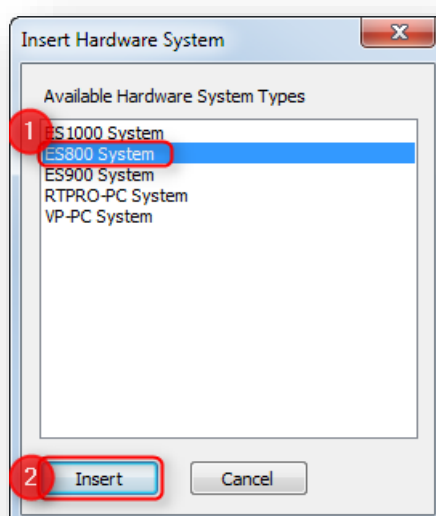
- Make sure that there is a hardware target in your system

Step by step guide

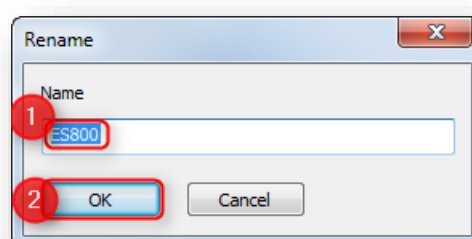
1. Under **Hardware** → **Hardware Systems**: Right mouse button click → **Add Hardware System ...**



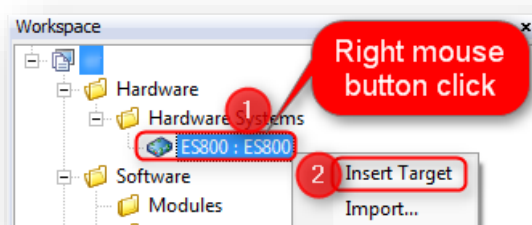
- In dialog **Insert Hardware System**: Select hardware system type, then click **Insert** button



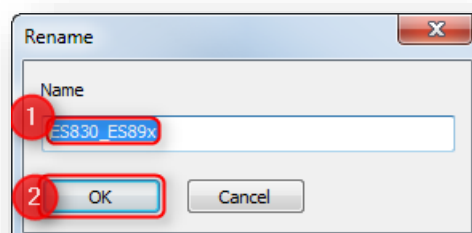
- In dialog **Rename**: Type a name, then click **OK** button



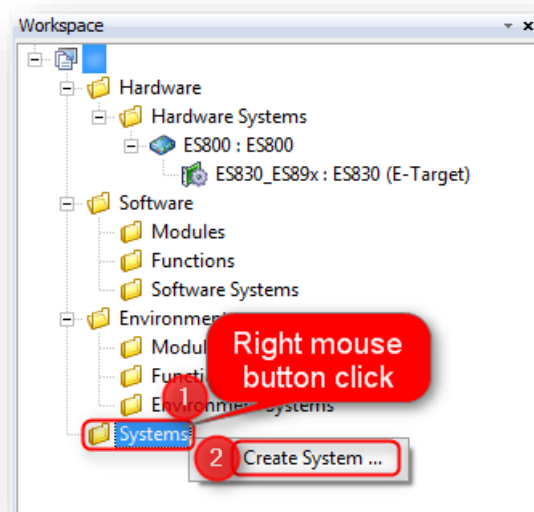
- On newly created hardware system: Right mouse button click → **Insert Target**



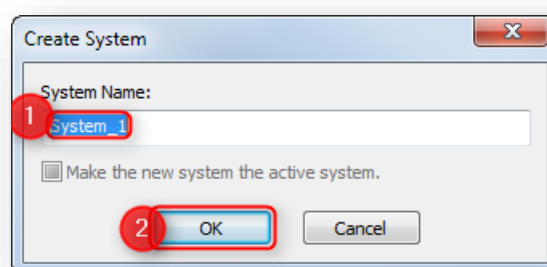
- In dialog **Rename**: Type a name, then click **OK** button



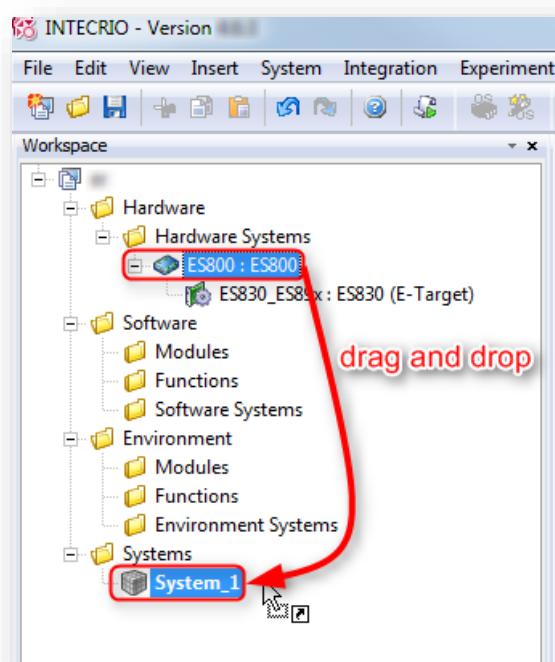
6. On **Systems**: Right mouse button click → **Create System ...**



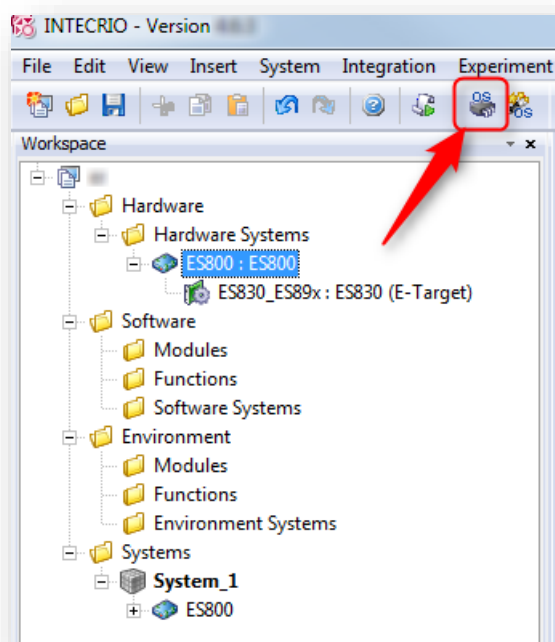
7. In dialog **Create System**: Type a name, then click **OK** button



8. Drag and drop the hardware system to the newly created system
