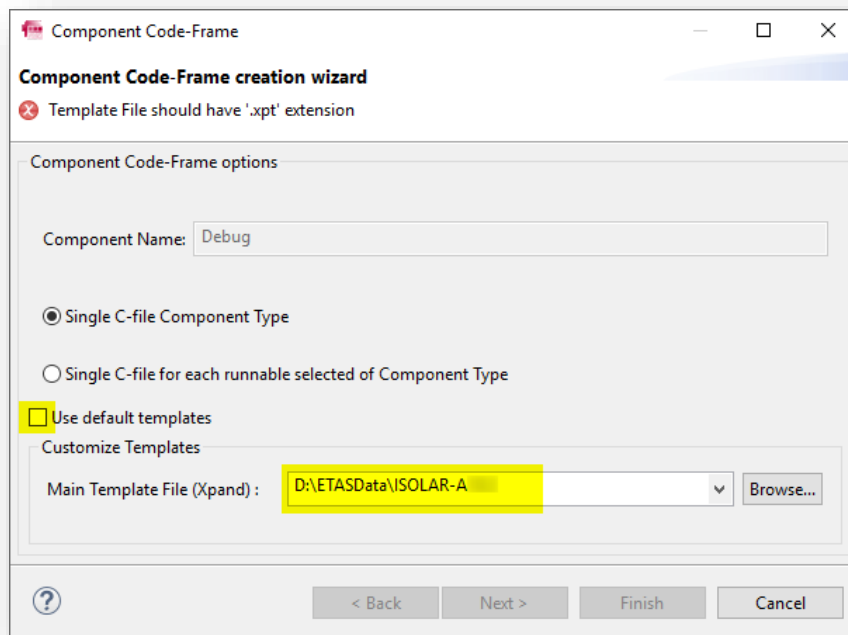




## Question:

2. The default template for "Component Code-Frame" (on adapter: right mouse button click → Generate → Component Code-Frame) already looks useful to me, but I want to add some c-code lines
3. Therefore, I plan to use an **own \*.xpt template**



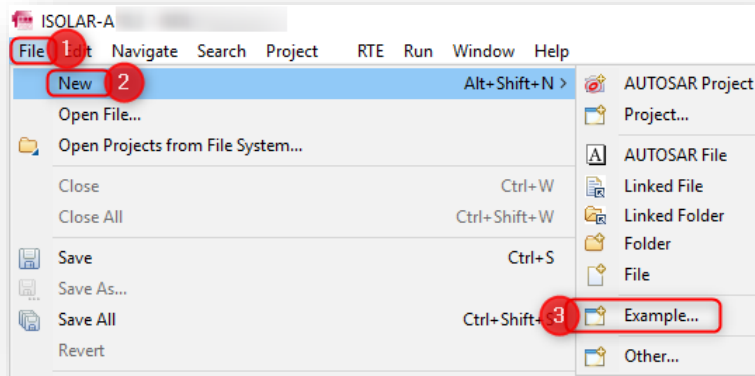
4. The default template is a very good basis for my own template:

5. Where are these default template files (\*.xpt files) stored? I cannot find them on my hard drive.



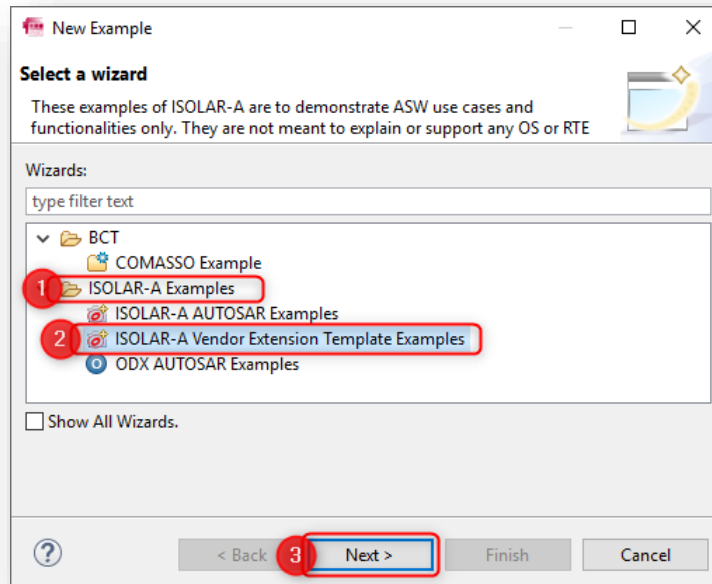
## Answer:

- The scripts are available in the examples provided by ISOLAR-A
- Find the scripts by following the steps provided below:

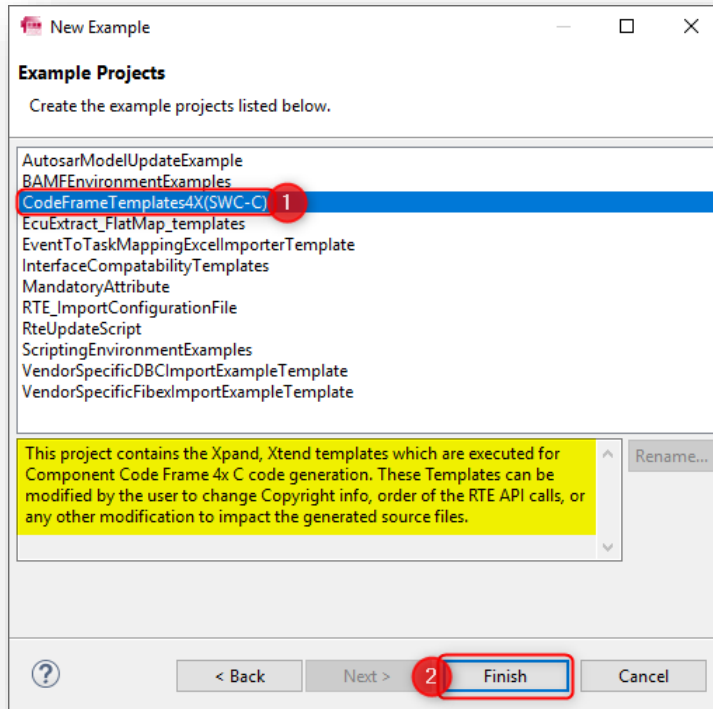
1. In **ISOLAR-A** → **Menu bar** → **File** → **New** → **Example...**



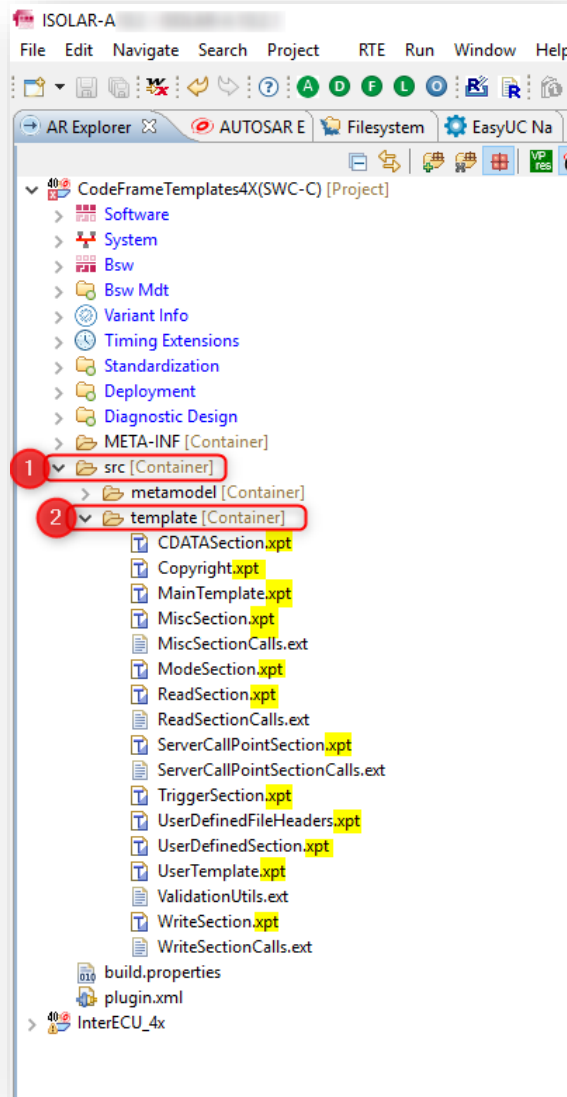
2. In dialog **New Example - Select a Wizard** → **ISOLAR-A Examples** → **ISOLAR-A Vendor Extension Template Examples** → Click **Next >** button



3. In dialog **New Example - Example Projects** → **CodeFrameTemplates4x(SWC-C)** →  
Click **Finish** button



4. Result: Find the \*.xpt files in the project under → **src** → **template**



## ATTENTION:

- If you want to copy these template files to some other directory and call the code generation from there:
  - The **parent folder** has to be called "**template**", otherwise the generation fails.
