


## ISOLAR - ASW4X\_GEN\_0005 - For the ..., the references ... are proxy.



- o In ISOLAR-A I receive an error message similar like the following:
  - For the <LifeCycleInfo>, the references [lcState] are proxy.
  - o For the ..., the references ... are proxy.







- Sometimes this error is in company with ASW4X DT 0034:


#### **Root Cause**

- ISOLAR uses the term "proxy references" if a reference is not resolving
  - For example if an AUTOSAR path together with the destination type does not resolve
- Reasons are:
  - Missing arxml files
  - Errors in arxml files (for example after incompatible changes in text/XML editors)
  - Splitable issues

### Solution

- This proxy reference will be automatically resolved if the reference target becomes available in the project.
- Option a) If you are following the example of the **Getting Started Guide**:
  - Replace file ECUConfigurationParameters.arxml in WiperControl\_4x with the one in InterECU 4x
- Option b) Manually fix every single entry:
- 1. Double click on error message in Problems Log
- 2. At **Quick fix** symbol (white X in red square in front of light bulb) → Click on black triangle at the right side → Click **Remove proxy and reconfigure the reference**





3. Repeat these steps for the other entries/error messages
